REGISTRATION

Registration for the train for media representatives is on Monday, **September, 6, 2011**, from **9.00 to 11.20** in the **VIP hall of the Yaroslavsky railway station** ([see map №1](#))

At three spots near the Yaroslavsky railway station – at the metro exit, at the pass near the main road, and at the metro entrance ([see map №1](#)) – volunteers and Directorate staff will be showing the way to the Registration Center. They will wear official GPF outfit.

The Registration Center is located in **the VIP hall of the Yaroslavsky railway station**. You will find a sign with GPF logo at the entrance to the station; it will help to find your way.

At the registration desk you will get **a ticket with your name** in it, the number of the couch and the seat. Volunteers will help you to get to your couch. At the boarding point you will have to show the ID you indicated during the registration, volunteers will check your name in the list and help you to get to your seat.

DEPARTURE

Branded train departs at **11.50**.

We ask you to register in time for the train. The train arrives at Yaroslavl railway station at 15.50.

Media representatives who would like to take GPF transfer and who did not indicate that while completing the accreditation form, must send an application to press@gpf-yar.ru, specifying the full name of Mass Media representative, Mass Media label and a request for the transfer.
