Global Policy Forum Press Center located **on the second floor of the SC 'Arena 2000'** is fully equipped for productive work of Mass Media at GPF.

The Press Center has 170 working places, 100 are equipped with stationary computers with the Internet access, and other working spots are set with sockets 220 V and Wi-Fi Internet access.

Besides the working area there are rooms for recreation and smoking in the Press Center.

The Press Center is also equipped with phones for intercity and international dialing, printers, scanners, and copy machines – everything that is essential for productive work of Mass Media.

MEALS

Mass Media representatives are provided with cold and hot drinks, and snacks at a food zone at the Press Center during all operating time of GPF.

The café on the third floor of SC 'Arena 2000' also provides hot meals for Media representatives three times a day during all operating time of GPF.

**Mass Media spots (Zones of Media partners)**

**Guest zones** for Media partners will work on September 7 and 8, 2011 on the second floor of the 'Arena 2000'. There, in the guest zones, participants of the Forum will give interviews and comments to the Mass Media. Information on Media meetings and briefings will be posted and updated at the central TV screen and in the information window of every stationary PC in the Press Center.

### **International Broadcasting Center**

For covering GPF events an **International Broadcasting Center (IBC)** will work at the Press Center.

A signal for the international TV program is formed by a **host broadcaster** - All-Russian State Television and Radio Broadcasting Company (**VGTRK/ Russia-24**), and is sent to working cabins in the Press Center.

The international TV program is formed by signals of live broadcasts from the events of GPF.

#### **Cabins for TV- and Radio companies**

There are specially equipped working cabins for TV companies (14) and radio companies (3) on the territory of the Press Center.

**TV cabins** have the size 2\*3 meters and are equipped with:

- two working tables and three chairs;
- a wastebasket;
- a local light source;
- a clothes rail;
- four plugs with grounding contact and electric power supply 220 V, and total capacity up to 3 kVA;
- one telephone line with a city number and an intercity, international dialing capacity with a socket connection RJ 11;
- an analogue telephone set with tone dialing;
- one line ISDN (EURO ISDN, interface S/T) with a city number and an intercity, international dialing capacity with a socket connection RJ 45;
- two LAN ports (socket connection RJ 45), allowing high speed Internet access;

Every **radio cabin has** the size 2\*2 meters, acoustical backing and is equipped with:

- one table and two chairs;
- a clothes rail;
- a wastebasket;
- a desk lamp;
- four electric plugs 220 V with grounding contact;
- two telephone lines with a city number and an intercity, international dialing capacity with a socket connection RJ11;
- an analogue telephone set with tone dialing;
- two lines ISDN (EURO ISDN, interface S/T) (one is a back up) with a city number;
- two LAN ports (socket connection RJ45), allowing high speed Internet access.

The signal of the international TV program is transmitted to the cabins in one of the **ten** working languages of GPF.
